
SCIENTIFIC NAME OF TARANTULA: "Theraphosa blondi"

DEFINITION

An arachnid is a class of arthropods that live on land. Spiders, mites, and ticks are arachnids.

A fully grown goliath birdeater tarantula is 12 inches across.

Tarantulas are hairy spiders. Spiders have four pairs of legs. Spiders are in a group of invertebrates called arachnids.

"Leiurus quinquestriatus"


Meet the scorpion. There are more than 1,500 known species of scorpion. We will use the death stalker scorpion in our battle.



Scorpions are also arachnids. They have two claws and an extended tail. The scorpion has a stinger on the end of its tail. Next to the stinger is the telson, which is filled with poison.

TARANTULA ANATOMY


Notice the segmented body, which is divided into two parts. The legs come out of the front part, the thorax. The back part is the abdomen.



It looks like tarantulas have ten legs, but they don't. The two legs beside their mouths are called palps. They are like arms. They help the tarantula move their food around.

SCORPION ANATOMY

Scorpions have two eyes on the top of their thorax and three to five pairs of eyes on the sides. The side eyes are called lateral eyes.



DID YOU KNOW?

Arachnids do not have antennae.


GLOWING FACT

Scorpions glow under black light because they reflect ultraviolet rays.

The tarantula's mouth has quite a bite. It carries poison in its fangs.
