- Using a catalog computer, search for adult level cookbooks at the Almonte Library, what is the Dewey Decimal call number of the book you found? See if you can find that book.

- Where are the Juvenile Graphic Novels located? Tween Graphic Novels?
- Where are the Board Books?
- Where are our Spanish children's items? How are they organized?
- Where are Award Winners kept for children?
