The purpose of this scavenger hunt is for you to acclimate to our collection if transferring from another location. If you cannot find the answer to these questions, feel free to ask a fellow staff member.

Adult

- Where is the Young Adult (YA) collection?
- Where is the Science Fiction Area?
- What genre(s) are interfiled with the Large Print Fiction collection? Which are separate?
- Do we have a World Language section or are they interfiled with the rest of the library collection?
- Where are Sequoyah items kept for intermediate and high school levels?
- Where is the new adult books shelving unit(s)?
- Using a catalog computer, search for adult level cookbooks at the Bethany Library, what is the Dewey Decimal call number of the book you found? See if you can find that book.

Children

- Where are the Juvenile Graphic Novels located? Tween Graphic Novels? Board Books?
- Which sections have genres interfiled for Children's?
- Where are Sequoyah items kept for children?
- Where are the AEBs for Easy and Reader books? How about AEBs for Tween and Juvenile?

A/V

- Where are the newspapers and magazines?
- In audio, are the formats separated or interfiled?
- In Children's Non-fiction DVDs, what are the different sections?
- Where are the Music CDs for children?
- Where is the New DVD shelving?

Other

- How many catalog computers do we have? Where are they?
- Where is the hold shelf area?
- How many display areas does Bethany have? Where are they located?
