Capitol Hill Collection Scavenger Hunt

Doing a walk through to explore the collection should take you about 30-60 minutes to complete. The purpose of walking through the collection is for you to spend time learning the collection before we start shelving training. If you cannot find the answer to these questions, feel free to ask a fellow staff member for assistance.

Take note of the spine labels including any genre or stickers. When you look at these spine labels and/or stickers, what do you notice about the collection you are in?

Different genres include Mystery, Science Fiction, Short Story, and Western. In Children's we also have Sports.

- What do you notice about each collection? Do any of the collections have genres interfiled?
- Where is the Young Adult (YA) collection? What do you notice about it? Note the differences in the spine label vs. a genre sticker.
- How are the children's graphic novels organized?
- Where are Sequoyah items kept for children and teens?
- What do you notice about the Large Print collection? Are genres interfiled? Where are Large Print Non-Fiction books?
- Where are the Spanish collections, both Fiction and Non-Fiction? What other materials are included in the Spanish Fiction section, in addition to the books?

- Where are the music CDs for children and adults?
- What is the difference in how magazines are shelved in the children's section vs the adult section?
- What is available in the family lounge area, in the children's section?
- Where are the new books for each age group?
- Where are Non-Fiction DVDs?
- Where are the different audio book options for children?
