

Southern Oaks Collection Scavenger Hunt

Doing a walk through to explore the collection should take you about 30-60 minutes to complete. The purpose of walking through the collection is for you to spend time learning the collection before we start shelving training. If you cannot find the answer to these questions, feel free to ask a fellow staff member for assistance.

Take note of the spine labels including any genre or stickers. When you look at these spine labels and/or stickers, what do you notice about the collection you are in?

Different genres include Mystery, Science Fiction, Short Story, and Western. In Children's we also have Sports.

- Find the Spanish aisle. How are the books organized by age level? What Spanish collection is *not* shelved in the Spanish aisle?
- What is different about our Music collection? Where are the J Music CDs? The Holiday CDs?
- There are three places in the collection where Award books are shelved. Where are they, and what awards are shelved in each place?
- Find the magazines. How long do we retain back issues?

- What do you notice about the way the YA books are shelved? Where are the YA DVDs?
- Look at how Oversized items are shelved in the ANF, JNF, and Juvenile Graphic Novel sections. What's different?
- What do you notice about the Large Print collection?
- Find the Citizenship Corner. What kind of items are shelved there?
- What is the difference between most of the items on the New Books display and the Recent Bestsellers display?
- Find the adult DVDs. What do you notice about how they are shelved?
