

Wright Library Collection Scavenger Hunt

Doing a walk through to explore the collection should take you about 10-15 minutes to complete. The purpose of walking through the collection is for you to spend time learning the collection before we start shelving training. If you cannot find the answer to these questions, feel free to ask a fellow staff member for assistance.

Take note of the spine labels including any genre or stickers. When you look at these spine labels and/or stickers, what do you notice about the collection you are in?

Different genres include Mystery, Science Fiction, Short Story, and Western. In Children's we also have Sports.

- What do you notice about each collection? Are different genres interfiled?
- What is interesting about adult graphic novels? Where are the adult graphic novels?
- Where is the Young Adult (YA) collection? What do you notice about it? Note the differences in the spine label vs. a genre sticker.
- What is the difference between Juvenile graphic novels vs. Tween graphic novels?

- Where are Sequoyah and Juvenile Award Winner items kept for children?
- Where are the Young Adult award winner and Sequoyah books located?
- What do you notice about the Large Print collection?
- Do we have a Spanish section or are they interfiled? (Hint: the Spanish items have genre stickers on them)
- What do you notice about where media is shelved in relation to the collection section?
