GETTING STARTED:

• The directions below are NOT for popular eReading devices like the Kindle Fire Family, the NOOK Color/Tablet/HD, Android devices, Apple devices, smart phones, and tablets. Instead, they are for E-Ink readers like the NOOK Simple Touch and GlowLight, Kobo Glo and Aura HD, and Sony Readers. Please visit <u>http://help.overdrive.com</u> to verify that your eBook reader is compatible with OverDrive's catalog.

EPUB eBooks (using Adobe Digital Editions on a Mac or Windows computer)
Note: If you have a Sony Reader Wi-Fi, you can download eBooks from your library right on your device, without the need for Adobe Digital Editions: <u>http://bit.ly/sonyrdr</u>.

eBooks

- Connect your eBook reader to your computer. Visit <u>http://bit.ly/adobeade</u>, click on **Download** at the top and follow the instructions to install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE).
- 2. After you have completed installation, you will need to authorize your computer by creating an Adobe ID, which is simply an email and password to "unlock" the digital "lock" on each eBook. If you aren't prompted to authorize your computer during the installation of ADE, simply click on the **Help** menu and choose **Authorize Computer**.
- 3. After you have authorized your computer, visit http://emedia.metrolibrary.org, click Sign In at the top right, and sign in with your full library card number and your full last name.
- 4. Browse or search for your eBook. Hover your mouse over the title and if you see the Borrow button, it means the title is available for immediate checkout. If you see the Place a Hold button, all copies of this book are currently checked out. Feel free to place a hold and you will be emailed when your title is available.
- 5. Click Download (Select one format), click Adobe EPUB eBook, and then click Confirm & Download.
- 6. This title should open automatically in ADE but if it does not, simply find where you downloaded the title and double-click it to open it in ADE.
- 7. To transfer an eBook to your eBook reader, make sure you're in ADE's "Library View" (you may need to click the Library button in the upper-left corner if you have the eBook open). From there, drag and drop the eBook onto your eBook reader, which should appear on the left under "Devices." You can now read the eBook on your eBook reader.

Note: During the transfer process, your eBook reader should be automatically authorized with the same Adobe ID you used on your computer.
