- ☐ ☐ 13. Is each walkway provided with a standard handrail on each exposed side? 1910.30(c)(2)
- ☐ ☐ 14. Are covers removed only from that portion of steaming vats on which employees are working and is a portable railing placed at this point to protect the operators? 1910.30(c)(3)
- ☐ ☐ 15. Are employees prohibited from riding or stepping on logs in steam vats? 1910.30(c)(4)
