NO MEMBERSHIPS NOR TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR. The event is free and open to the public on Saturday and Sunday. Friends membership is an annual gift/commitment to the Friends of the Library and is not affiliated with a library card.

- **Better Books** – items in better condition or are harder to find treasures. Items are individually priced starting at \$3 each;
- **Carol's Corner** – rare, signed, and collectible books and materials individually priced at \$3 and up.

Not Your Average Joe's will be onsite throughout the event promoting their mission and offering treats for sale.

Members and volunteers will be treated to a free treat experience (while supplies last) during the member and volunteer pre-shop on Oct. 5th.

Children under 12 do not need tickets for the membership day.

Due to space constraints, please no carts or wagons for this event.

Parking is free and available in the garage next to the Community Impact Center.
