# **Talking Points**

# Holds can now be placed on all library materials.

All fiction materials can now be found in one place in the library.

## Harlequin materials are still together, by series and by date.

- All Harlequin publications may be found by checking FICTION HQN in either the regular print or large print area.
- All Harlequin series (such as Love Inspired) are shelved together.
- Each series is easily identified by issue date.
- Each series is shelved by issue date.
- Shelving is likely to be more accurate, reducing the chance that titles will be missed while browsing.
- Harlequin series may now be searched in the catalog.

### Star trek and Star wars titles are kept together.

- All Star wars titles may be found by checking SCIENCE FICTION STA\_WAR in the adult, young adult, or juvenile area.
- All Star trek titles are shelved immediately in front of Star wars and may be found by checking SCIENCE FICTION STA\_ in the adult, young adult, or juvenile areas.
- Star trek titles are separated by TV series and easily identified by abbreviations.
- Graphic novels and text novels are shelved the same way.

### Lego titles are kept together.

 All Lego fiction titles may be found by checking FICTION LEGO in the juvenile or tween area.

# Materials formerly in paperback collections are made available to members more quickly.

- Series identification makes it easy for members to locate or be directed to their favorite series.
- Where applicable, date identification makes it easy for members to locate the latest publication.
- Series identification allows library staff to locate materials to fill holds easily, reducing wait time for members.
- Series identification allows library staff to return materials to shelves faster, making them available to members earlier.
- MLS staff at all levels have more free time to devote to assisting members.

### Harlequin publishers series

Refers to all titles published by the Harlequin publishing group. The library receives a number of series on standing order; 4-6 titles per series are received each month.

Apply to titles in the **adult fiction collection**.

Spine labels will consist of:

The classification FICTION

The cutter HQN, followed by an underscore and an abbreviation for the individual series (in the examples below, Intrigue and Desire).

The month and year of the title's issue.

The series title, title of the work, and the author's name appear at the left side of the label.

Library staff will shelve materials first by the classification, FICTION; then by the publisher, HQN; then by the series; then by the date, March 2015. If desired, materials may then be shelved based on the author's last name. See examples below.

The title will be preceded by the name of the individual series (i.e., Kimani, Nocturne, etc.). Some series will require abbreviation. An entry for the individual book title will be added.

#### Star Trek series

Refers to fiction titles that utilize characters, settings, etc., based on Star trek television programming. Series included are: Star trek (the original series, known as TOS), Star trek: the next generation (TNG), Star trek: Deep space 9 (DS9), and Star trek: Voyager (VOY).

Apply to titles in the adult and young adult collections, both text and graphic format. Do not apply to graphic format series which have been established under the character name.

Spine labels will consist of:

The classification SCIENCE FICTION

The cutter STA, followed by an underscore and an abbreviation for the individual series. Titles which do not feature a specific program are designated TRE. (In the examples below, the left label is for the original series; the right label does not feature a specific program).

The series title, title of the work, and the author's name appear at the left side of the label.

The title will be preceded by "Star trek" and, if applicable, an abbreviation for the associated television program. If there is no associated program, the title will simply be preceded by "Star trek". An entry for the individual book title will be added.

A series added entry will include the term "Star trek", and the program name spelled out. If the title is part of another named series, a second series added entry will be included.

#### Star Wars series

Refers to fiction titles that utilize characters, settings, etc., based on the Star wars films. All fiction titles relating to Star wars are considered to be part of one series.

Apply to titles in the adult, young adult, and juvenile areas, both text and graphic format. Do not apply to graphic format series which have been established under the character name.

Spine labels will consist of:

The classification SCIENCE FICTION

The cutter STA\_WAR

The series title, title of the work, and the author's name appear at the left side of the label.

With this call number scheme, library staff will shelve materials first by the classification, SCIENCE FICTION; then by the grouping, STA\_WAR. This allows Star wars titles to be shelved separately from Star trek. Materials may then be shelved based on the author's last name and/or the title. See examples below.

# Lego series

Refers to fiction titles that utilize character illustrations in the Lego style.

Apply to titles in the **juvenile**, **tween**, and possibly **reader** collections, both text and graphic format.

Spine labels will consist of:

The appropriate classification

The cutter LEGO

The series title, title of the work, and the author's name appear at the left side of the label.

Library staff will shelve materials first by the classification, then by the grouping LEGO. Materials may then be shelved based on the author's last name and/or the title. See examples below.

# Relabeling/New Labels

Cataloging will not recall and relabel cataloged materials in newly designated series. Libraries are not to send materials to Cataloging specifically for relabeling.

Libraries are not to create temporary BIDs nor item numbers for any material, including mass market paperbacks.

If a library sends an individual item to Cataloging for replacement of the barcode/spine label due to loss, damage, etc., Cataloging staff will change the spine/barcode label to reflect the series designation. The call number and title appearing in the catalog record will not be changed.

If all copies of an individual title are requested by Cataloging for correction of issues not related to series, staff will change the call number and title in the catalog record and on all items to reflect the series designation, and relabel all items before return.

August 1, 2017 - First day to send Cataloging Consideration requests for evaluation of other series

December 1, 2017 - All weeding and intershelving of mass market paperback collections completed
