Emergencies R Us

Did you see the recent email sent out by Security Manager **Linda Hyams** reminding us all how to react to a medical emergency? No? Well in that case we better publish it again, just so everyone will know what to do. It's a reminder Linda sends out every few years, but it's information that never goes out of date. Take a look and remember that you saw it in the September, 2011 issue of ShelfLife so you can check back later for a brush-up.

And we second what Linda added as a postscript—when a customer is having a medical emergency, staff can help by clearing the area and keeping other staff and customers away from the area who are not directly involved in care of the patient. This will keep the area clear for EMSA and give the customer privacy.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW IN A MEDICAL EMERGENCY

A medical emergency can be a scary situation, whether it involves a customer or a coworker. A few simple tips can make you better prepared.

WHEN TO CALL

Some folks are afraid to call 911 because they are unsure whether their medical condition or complaint rises to the level of an emergency. Calling a physician for advice is a good place to start, but physicians aren't always readily available and many will end up telling patients to call 911 anyway.

There are specific conditions that should not wait for a call back from the family doctor before calling 911. These medical conditions are time sensitive — waiting too long could have serious consequences, even death. Additionally, there are protocols in place to ease the transition from the ambulance to the hospital emergency department. A family physician will probably not have the tools necessary to treat life-threatening events in his or her office.

When experiencing one of the following conditions, call 911 immediately:

Anaphylaxis
Chest pain (see heart attack)
Confusion
Drug overdose
Heat stroke
Shortness of breath
Stroke
Uncontrolled bleeding
Vomiting blood
Serious Burns
Bleeding with weakness (shock)
Broken leg

Bloody diarrhea
Coma (unresponsive victim)
Dizziness
Heart attack
Rectal bleeding
Slurred speech
Sudden blindness (see stroke)
Uncontrolled nose bleed
Weakness
Bleeding that will not stop
Broken bones visible through an open
wound

This is certainly not an exhaustive list. It's important to understand that emergencies are defined by the victim; if you feel you are having a medical emergency, call 911 immediately.

How to Call 911

- Stay calm... Stay with the victim if it's not you! It's
 important to take a deep breath and not get excited.
 Any situation that requires 911 is, by definition, an
 emergency. The 911 dispatcher knows that and will
 try to move things along quickly, but under control.
- 2. If the victim is unable to call, the caller should be someone with the victim. If you have security, have someone notify security of the emergency. They will help route the emergency responders to the appropriate place. Do not call security first! This will only delay the response time. Security will not have the necessary information to share with the 911 dispatcher.
- 3. Start by telling 911 what kind of emergency you have. Be descriptive and give as much information as possible. If a law enforcement center has answered the call, they will need to transfer calls for fires and medical emergencies to the appropriate center. You will hear clicking do not hang up!

- 4. Wait for the dispatcher to ask questions, and then answer clearly and calmly. Even though many 911 centers have enhanced capabilities meaning they are able to see your location on the computer screen they are still required to confirm the information. Bear with this line of questioning; you don't want the ambulance to respond to the wrong location.
- 5. If you are in danger of assault, the 911 dispatcher will still need you to answer quietly, mostly "yes" and "no" questions.
- 6. If you reach a recording, listen to what it says. If the recording says your call cannot be completed, hang up and try again. If the recording says all 911 operators are busy, wait! When the next 911 dispatcher is available to take the call, it will transfer you.
- 7. Let 911 guide the conversation. He or she is typing the information into a computer and may seem to be taking forever. There's a good chance, however, that emergency services are already being sent while you are still on the line.
- 8. In some cases, 911 will give you directions. Listen carefully, follow each step exactly, and ask for clarification if you don't understand.
- 9. Keep your eyes open. You may be asked to describe victims, suspects, vehicles, or other parts of the scene.
- 10. Do not hang up the call until directed to do so by 911.

Final Tips:

- 1. No matter what happens Stay Calm.
- 2. Take a deep breath.
- 3. Know where you are.
- 4. Make sure your emergency contact information is updated. If not, notify HUM with the corrections.

ibrary programmers never receive the thanks they deserve for working so hard to bring people into the library. After all, the rest of us can't sell library services to people who never come in to see us and programming is one of the best ways to, as they say in show business, "put the butts in the seats."

To get a better look into the minds of our programmers, ShelfLife asked them recently what they are currently reading. Here's what we found out...

Jennifer Jones at CH: Jennifer is currently reading *Sorta Like a Rock Star* by Matthew Quick, a YA novel about an upbeat Catholic girl who spreads joy and happiness while keeping her own difficulties at home very quiet. The book has been described as: "the answer to all those angst-ridden and painfully grim novels in the shortcut lingo of short attention-span theater." Jennifer's also been checking out *Water for Elephants* by Sarah Gruen.

Anita Roesler at OUT: Accusing herself of having a bad case of reader's ADD, Anita's reading When Ireland Fell Silent by Harolyn Ennis, historical fiction set during the time of the Great Potato Famine in 19th century Ireland. Ennis will be presenting a series of library talks about the book later this month.

Anita is also reading *Boomers and Beyond: Reconsidering the Role of Libraries* by Pauline Rothstein and Diantha Dow Schull; *Now You See Her* by James Patterson and Michael Ledwidge; and *The Wild Hog Murders* by Bill Crider.

Lynda Toney-Bahr at OUT: Lynda is currently reading *Glad No Matter What*, an uplifting look at how to live an inspired life in spite of hard times and personal disappointments, by SARK (Susan Ariel Rainbow Kennedy).

And from **Kristin Williamson** at MC who is currently reading *Tesla: a Man out of Time* by Margaret Cheney, *The Throne of Fire* by Rick Riordan, and listening to *The Feynman Lectures* by Richard Feynman.

WHO KNEW?

You can find a fascinating article on the Accredited Online Colleges webpage--http://www.accreditedon-linecolleges.com/blog/2011/20-celebrities-with-stunning-home-libraries with photos of the personal libraries of some pretty well-known folks. Celebrities read? Who knew?

You may have read of Rolling Stones guitarist Keith Richards' secret passion for librarianship, but here you can take a look at his library, one of the few in the article that looks as if it's actually used frequently. Another one that looks lived-in belongs to cookbook author Nigella Lawson (MLS owns eight of her books), with items stacked up on the floor. Her work space looks like mine—I love it. You can see a picture of Agatha Christie's library in her summer home in Devon, the shelves topped by a large frieze painted by the

American soldiers who used the home for quarters during WWII.

But first place goes easily to Karl Lagerfeld, the German designer and creative director for the fashion house Chanel. (He also helms his own label fashion house, as well as the Italian house Fendi.) The library in his Paris apartment contains over 60,000 volumes.

Other celebs on the tour include, among others, Oprah Winfrey, Woody Allen, Sting, Mark Twain, Jane Fonda, Michael Jackson, and our least-favorite pop singer, Rod Stewart. Our Choice in eReaders

We asked staff last month to let us know what kind of eReaders they have and we heard back from a handful of people about their likes and dislikes. Here's what we found out.

Constant reader **Jana Haus-burg**, Assistant Manager of Library Operations at NW (and faithful book reviewer for *info* magazine) has a Nook. "Mine is the early one, which I'm not fond of. I'd like something less clunky."

Denise Courts, in HUM, wrote, "I use the iPod touch as my read-



er. It downloads emedia ebooks and audio books. It is small, but that is what I like. I can carry it in my purse or pocket and anytime I have to wait on something I can pass the time while I catch up on my reading. I also like the Touch because it is not just a reader. So I have a multi-tasking device."

Denise's HUM colleague **Kasandra Dewbre-Burrows** also likes the iPod Touch. "I occasionally use my iPod Touch to read books from Overdrive. I like that it's portable so if I find myself standing in line at the bank or waiting at the doctor's office I always

have my book with me... as long as my iPod is charged! I still prefer the weight and texture of a book in my hands and I love that my marathon reading sessions are never interrupted by that annoying 'Low Battery' alert."

Nancy Lytle, in MaC, received a Kindle as a gift a couple of years ago and likes its small size and easy portability. She also likes the variety of things available for downloading and the fact that books and newspapers (of which she reads several) can be downloaded instantly. Her main dislike is that returning to read a part of the book she's already read is difficult.

Doug Bentin in MaC (aka, me) has a SONY eReader and likes the fact that he can download word documents easily. "I'm a fan of 19th century fiction and when I find some obscure titles online I sometimes have to turn them into word documents before I can put them into the reader. More and more things are downloadable instantly now than were available when I got the reader in 2009, but this is a feature I still use frequently."
