The Right Tools for the Right Job - do volunteers have them?



"The right tool for the right job" has been an ad slogan used by True Temper since at least 1907. This may not have been the first use of the saying, but it did help popularize it in America. This popular saying still holds true today in the volunteer arena. How can we ensure that each volunteer has the materials and equipment he or she needs to complete assigned tasks?

The best way to ensure all equipment is ready for a volunteer is to actually complete the task once yourself before the volunteer is scheduled to arrive. You can then gather any missing items, plus you'll have a finished sample to share! If this task is repetitive you may want to make a list of

the supplies needed, and keep it with the project. This way if another staff member is training a volunteer, the guesswork will be removed!

The right tool for the right job -- simple enough, but still important to consider after 100 years!
