

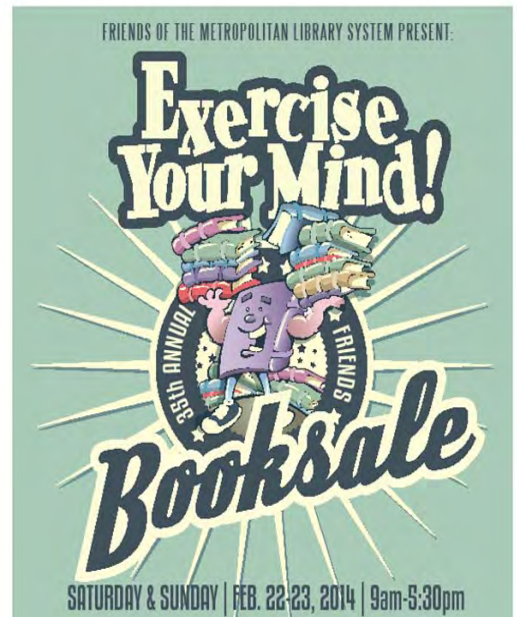
## Share your volunteer management skills at Book Sale!
