Put yourself in their shoes - what does a volunteer really want?

1. To understand the expectations of their volunteer job.

- 1. To understand the expectations of their volunteer job.
- 2. To be assigned jobs according to their skills and needs.
- 3. To understand why they are doing a task.
- 4. To know that records are kept on them for tax purposes.
- 5. To have a supervisor (you!) someone to look to.
- 6. To be included in some of the decisions that affect volunteers when possible.
- 7. To have their ideas heard and responded to.
- 8. To be recognized for their work.
- 9. To know that they are part of something larger than themselves.
- 10. To understand the importance of the role they play in making the future happen.
