Characteristics of Historical Fiction

- 1. **PACING** Usually large books that unfold at a leisurely pace. Even shorter novels are densely written so they must be read slowly.
- 2. **STORY LINE** May focus on a specific event or time period, they may follow a character (real or fictional). May raise difficult social or moral issues.
- 3. **CHARACTERIZATION** May be real or fictional but fit into the time period. Their lives and actions are shaped by the historical times and details, not vice versa



- 4. FRAME/SETTING Wealth of accurate historical detail relating to setting as well as characters and events.
- 5. **TONE/MOOD** Mood varies widely, mood may be a factor (even if not acknowledged) in reading choices
- 6. **STYLE/LANGUAGE** Can affect a reader's experience with the novel. Some readers appreciate an 'authentic' style and others find it distracting. Dialects and formats may also affect the reader's reaction.
