


2022 OLA Gold Leadership ~ Applications Open!

Reserving Meeting Rooms Tutorial

As meeting rooms open for our guests, Central Information Services has updated the Reserving Meeting Rooms tutorial on the Intranet. For a quick refresher go to Intranet > Departments > L&D > How-To's.



Multiple Sclerosis (MS) is a condition that affects the central nervous system and early symptoms may include vision problems, muscle weakness, tingling or numbness in arms or legs, fatigue, and balance issues. This is because the immune system attacks the myelin sheath, which is a substance that covers and protects nerve cells.

MS is a chronic condition that can change and progress over time. Although there is no cure, there are many effective treatments that can help with symptoms and slow the progression.

What causes MS is not fully understood, but there are certain risk factors. While you may not have control over some, others can be avoided:

Genetics: Your chances of developing it are slightly higher if a close relative, such as a parent or sibling, has the condition.

Sex: Women are 2-3 times more likely to develop MS.

Low vitamin D or low sun exposure: Vitamin D plays a crucial role in immunity, whether it's obtained through the sun, food, or supplements. Because it's easiest to metabolize vitamin D through sun exposure, people who live in areas with less sun have a greater risk.

Smoking: Smokers may have double the risk.

Chemical exposure: Some studies have found a link between exposure to air pollution and organic solvents in paints, adhesives, and lacquers.

Viral infections: There is a possibility that having been exposed to certain viruses increases the risk, including Epstein-Barr, human herpes virus-6, varicella-zoster (the chickenpox virus), and others.
